The Mt. Vaca Radio Club, Inc. (MVRC), operates repeater station K6MVR on 2 Meters and UHF, from locations on Mt. Vaca (2800 ft) near Vacaville and within the Sacramento area for communications over a wide area. All Amateurs are welcome to use the open repeaters and in open contacts which do not impede the use by others. The systems provide reliable coverage for mobile stations throughout the Sacramento Valley region beyond Modesto, Oroville, the Sierras, and portions of the Bay Area.

ACTIVITIES:

The MVRC Club provides radio communications for Public Service activities (bike rides, parades) and emergency communication as needed for the American Red Cross or other agencies. We enjoy a variety of social activities including mobile radio trips, camping trips, 4WD trips, dinners (pot luck), and other times to "play radio".

NET:

The Club net is conducted weekly each Monday at 7:45 PM to bring MVRC members, sponsors and system users together for announcements of club activities, then followed by check ins. Visitors are invited to check in.

Meetings:

Quarterly club meetings are held at various locations in the Sacramento Valley area. The *Mt. Vaca News* is published quarterly and sent to members and sponsors. The *Mt. Vaca News* contains a calendar of events, technical projects, public service and social events, and roster.

REPEATERS:

The following repeaters are part of the MVRC (WA6UGY) systems:

1. VHF 147.00 MHz (-) Open System
PL 136.5 Hz
2. UHF 1282.050 MHz (-) Open System
PL 88.5 Hz
3. UHF 444.00 MHz (+) (Members only)

Since these are high level repeaters, we use a 30 second timer. This allows many users to make contact using short transmissions, much like face-to-face conversations.

Operational note:

When the system is being used for Public Service please give that traffic priority.

MEMBERSHIP:

Support for the MVRC comes from our MVRC Members and MVRC Sponsors. Membership in the MVRC brings authority to command the systems to various configurations.

To become a member submit a application with first year dues (\$48.00). Other Hams in the family are included as associate members with no additional fee.

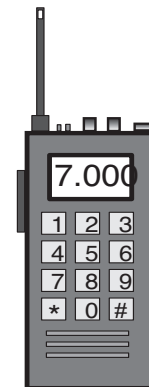

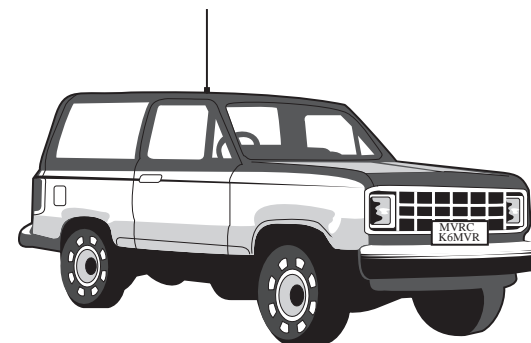
